## **Doctor of Theology**

#### **OVERVIEW**

The Doctor of Theology is a 54-credit hour resident post-graduate degree with a concentration in Theology and New Testament. It is designed to give those who have a graduate degree a higher level of competency in theology and biblical exposition. Our Doctor of Theology (ThD) is not designed to be a pastoral degree, it is a higher education degree that is open to both men and women. We offer three options to choose from for the final assessment in the program. He/She may choose a dissertation, a ministry project, or a comprehensive exam.

- Communicate God's Word effectively through preaching or teaching
- Ability to evangelize culturally and cross-culturally

- Develop a complete Biblical Worldview with the ability to apply it to every area of life
- The ability to analyze, compare, and contrast worldviews that are antithetical to the Christian Worldview
- Advanced understanding of major contemporary social, cultural, and theological issues challenging Christianity today
- Develop the tools and skills necessary for further research and study to cultivate a lifelong biblical learning process
- Enhance your ministerial skills such as, preaching, teaching, counseling, leadership, administration, education, evangelism, or spiritual formation

### **ADMISSION**

Admission into the Doctor of Theology requires a Master of Divinity (min 72 credit hrs.) or its equivalent. The remaining admission requirements are listed below.

- Sign doctrinal agreement statement
- Supply two references (preferably one pastoral and one academic)
- Provide transcript(s)
- Provide a Master's level academic paper (exegetical or research)
- A personal bio describing yourself and your purpose for the Doctor of Theology Degree.
