OVERVIEW

The Master of Arts in Apologetics is a 54 credit hour degree designed to provide the student with advanced knowledge in defending the rationale and superiority of the Christian Worldview. It equips the student to compare and contrast Christianity with all other competing religions and worldviews at a philosophical, scientific, and biblical level. Moreover, the Master of Arts in Apologetics strengthens one's ability to effectively evangelize in the multi diverse culture of the day. The degree is designed simply to teach Christians what they believe, why they believe it, provide adequate justification for it, and successfully defend it. The capstone of the degree is the student's choice of a thesis, comprehensive exam, or a ministry project.
